With the support of AmeriCorps, we are currently seeking community service-oriented individuals to be a part of this exciting initiative, the Family Village Project.

AmeriCorps members must commit to 900 hours of service (approximately 20 hours per week) which must be completed within one year in exchange for a living stipend of \$5,771 and an educational award of \$2,362.
